"The New Geopolitical Environment in the Middle East: between Fighting Terrorism and the Future of the Region" is an event organized by the Bucharest-based think-tank the Middle East Political and Economic Institute (MEPEI), the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran to Romania, and the EURISC Foundation.

We organize this event with a view to address salient international affairs. The Middle East has never been a simple place, holding its special standing in international geopolitics, being characterized by the complexity of the security milieu and strategic energy resources. The region has been confronted with significant challenges over the last years, subsequent to the strengthening of terrorist groups' operational methods, posing more challenges than ever in an already volatile environment.

Threats nowadays are not isolated, given the current transnational context, thus the purpose of this Conference is to promote an approach that highlights commitment to the fight against all forms of violence, including its extreme version, namely *terrorism*. In addressing this complex issue, we should focus on four main pillars: prevent, protect, pursue, and respond. In addition, a complete strategy recognises the importance of cooperation with third countries and international institutions. The in-depth analysis offered by the experts attending the Conference enables us to study a vicious phenomenon and deliver perspective solutions for the future of the region. Moreover, the Forum is envisaged as an occasion to benefit from the expertise of government representatives, renowned analysts and scholars from different countries, who are all directly engaged with the matter.

The event is supported by the Tubman Company and Victor Bălășoiu Law House, Romania, in partnership with the Institute for Political and International Studies (IPIS/MFA, Iran), the Institute for Middle East Strategic Studies (Tehran, Iran), and the Chamber of Commercial Diplomacy with Iran (Bucharest).
