This book, which outlines the Organisation for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE) standing at the beginning of the 21st century, explores the challenges posed by the growing global crisis in multilateralism and the increased geopolitical polarisation on institutions such as the OSCE. This book also looks at the OSCE’s response to this changing global context, and the opportunities that have emerged from this environment. In the two hours allocated to this book launch, Amb.
